

**SELECTION OF FRENCH GOVERNMENT SCHOLARSHIP HOLDERS  
AWARDED THROUGH THE EMBASSY OF FRANCE IN INDIA  
FOR HIGHER STUDIES IN FRANCE FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2009-2010**

The scholarship awarded by the French Government through the Embassy of France in India is meant for attracting more and more Indian students to undertake higher studies in France. The scholarship holders will benefit an allowance of 615 euros/month for the boarding and lodging expenses along with a medical insurance (social security) coverage managed by EGIDE (Scholars' agency in France). The First month allowance will be given in France to the students from the date of commencement of the scholarship and then the monthly allowance will be credited, in the first week of every month, to the students bank account opened in France. EGIDE can also help the French Government scholarship holders to get an accommodation reserved for them on their arrival in France. Those who wish to have an accommodation arranged by EGIDE, should inform in advance the person in charge of the scholarship at the Embassy of France his/her desire to do so, at the time of submitting the filled in application form of the allotment of scholarship. The candidates who have been selected will be intimated directly through e-mail about their selection as well as the procedures to be followed to obtain the scholarship once they join the course in France. The selected candidates immediately must go through the websites of Campus France ([www.india-campusfrance.org](http://www.india-campusfrance.org)) or the Embassy of France ([www.france-in-india.org](http://www.france-in-india.org)) in India, to know the student visa formalities for France.
