The Ministry of Foreign and European Affairs and DCNS partners for welcome of foreign students in France

### « DCNS / MAEE » Program INVITATION FOR APPLICATIONS Academic Year 2009-2010

The ministry of Foreign and European Affairs (MAEE) and DCNS Group have decided on the 9<sup>th</sup> April 2008 to create a scholarship program to welcome and assist foreign students for higher studies in France.

This network is founded on a public / private partnership. It aims at the establishment of optimal and personalized conditions of reception and joint selection of students between the MAEE, DCNS and the partners of the French establishments of higher education.

For the second year of this program, 15 scholarships are will be awarded.

#### FOR WHAT TYPE OF STUDIES?

The « DCNS / MAEE » scholarship for studies in France is meant for one year **Master 1, Master 2 or Specialised Master's studies** in the field of:

- ❖ **Engineering Sciences**
- Or
- ❖ **Economics, Management**

In one of the following establishments of higher education:

- **Ecole Naval de Brest:** for 12 months studies in Master 2 {(minimum required level: 1<sup>st</sup> year Master's degree (Master 1) and French language evaluation test 2 (360)}
- **Ecole Centrale de Nantes:** for 22 months studies in Master 1 & 2 (complete program – minimum level required: Bachelor's degree)
- **Audencia Nantes:** for 16 Months studies in Master 1 (minimum required level: Bachelor's degree)
- **Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Ingénieurs des Etudes et Techniques d'Armement (ENSIETA):** for 12 months studies in Specialised Master program {minimum level required: 2<sup>nd</sup> year Master's degree (Master 2)} – based on accreditation of Master's program

(\*)The candidates who apply for the scholarship must enrol simultaneously in one of partner establishments of the program. The amount of tuition fees, chargeable to the student, differs according to the establishments. The French Government scholarship holders who have been enrolled in the public higher education establishments are only exempted from the payment of tuition fees.

## WHAT ARE THE PROPOSED ADVANTAGES?

- ❖ The award of a scholarship by DCNS includes:
  - living expenses allowances amount of 600 € per month for the entire duration of the academic program (apart from training period);
  - total amount of tuition fees
- ❖ monthly bonus amount of 1000 € during company training paid by DCNS
- ❖ coaching within DCNS;
- ❖ training done within DCNS group;
- ❖ after obtaining the diploma, a job contract proposal to engaged & enthusiast students who shares the ambitions and the values of venture;
- ❖ intensive training in French before the departure organised by the Alliances Française by the intermediary of the French Embassy;
- ❖ award of French Government scholarship holder status by the MAEE;
- ❖ coverage of social security;
- ❖ personalized housing allowance benefit

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE ?

Students:

- Indians;
- Aged below 30 years in the year of selection;
- Not already beneficiary of any scholarships from the French Government;
- Whose application for a scholarship from the French Government has not already been rejected previously;

### Important Remarks:

- Students having dual nationality are not eligible
- Applications relating to a training in study or aiming for continued education are straightaway rejected
- Fairly good command of the French language is not a pre-requisite but an added advantage at the time of selection and a goal to be achieved at the end of the student's stay in France. Ecole Navale de Brest requires French language proficiency test level 2 (TEF 2 - 360) to follow the course, which is 50% in French and 50% in English.

## WHEN DOES THE SELECTION TAKE PLACE ?

**Till 24th April 2009:** Acceptance of applications by the Cultural Service of the Embassy of France in India;

**Between 24<sup>th</sup> April & 13<sup>th</sup> May 2009:** Pre-selection of the candidates takes place in the country of origin of the student under the authority of the Embassy of France and the Higher Education Establishment in France;

**13th May 2009:** Despatch of convocation letter to the pre-selected candidates for a personal interview at the premises of the Embassy of France;

**Between 16<sup>th</sup> and 30th May 2009:** Final selection takes place in India by a committee consisting of representatives of the Ministry of Higher Education, establishments of Higher Education in France and a Manager of DCNS. The list of candidates selected will be declared on this day.

The list of selected candidates is published on the websites of the Ministry of Foreign and European affairs, DCNS and the French Embassy of the country of the origin of the student.

## HOW DOES THE SELECTION TAKE PLACE ?

The criteria taken in consideration for the selection of the candidates are the following:

- ❖ excellence of the candidate, as shown by his previous University records;
- ❖ candidate's professional project;
- ❖ level of English language knowledge
- ❖ Ecole Navale de Brest requires French language proficiency test level 2 (TEF 2 - 360) to follow the course
- ❖ Interest of student for the DCNS trade;
- ❖ In case of an equality of level and competences, the persons in charge of the program will have the privilege to stick to the candidates with modest resources.
