Information	General Conditions Award of the Ile-de-France Master's Scholarship is subject to the student's acceptance of the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- undertaking to follow the entire course regularly at the same institution at which he has been selected;- stay in the single room reserved and financed by the Ile-de-France Region at the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris throughout his academic year in Ile-de-France;- taking up internships or research related to the academic programme, in Ile-de-France as a priority. All periods spent outside Ile-de-France will lead to a pro-rata reduction of the scholarship.- arrival in France unaccompanied;- undertaking to submit the evaluation report required at the end of the financed Master's programme, whatever be its outcome.
	Scholarship Amount The Regional grant of 10,500 Euros for an academic year (minimum period of 9 consecutive months required) is paid directly by the Cité Internationale Universitaire de Paris, once accommodation charges have been deducted. For information, a student pursuing a 9-month course will receive a monthly allowance of almost 800€. The Region provides no other financial or material aid.
	The scholarship does not aim at paying or exempting the student from: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- the total amount of tuition fees in the host institution;- expenses related to administrative formalities for entry and residence in France;- social security coverage and various insurance expenses in France;- transport expenses from the country of origin to France.
